Certified Wildlife Habitat

Moore Traditional School is fortunate to have a wildlife area with acres of trees and meadows highlighted by a spring-fed stream. Environmental students have enhanced this area with the construction of a nature trail, a butterfly garden, a tree nursery, and a bird feeder station. Our Wildlife Habitat has been certified by the **National Wildlife Federation**. Our Environmental Program uses our wildlife habitat as an outdoor classroom. Students can observe plants, animals and other organisms in their natural surroundings. They have catalogued a number of plant and animal species. Students can investigate functioning ecosystems up close. They can conduct water, air and soil investigations right on our campus. Students can experience nature by walking the trail along the creek and through the woods.
