Subject of the Policy: **Assignment of Students to Classes**

Policy Statement

For Grades 6-8, the students are divided evenly between the different teams. The students are scheduled in homerooms and classes by the team leaders, counselors or administrators. Classes that students take are in agreement with the JCPS Middle School Progression, Promotion and Grading Procedures publication, JCPS Policies and SBDM Policies. Some of the factors that relate to student placement are special needs, related arts requests and parent requests (given prior to team placement).

For Grades 9-12 students are placed in courses based on student/parent requests, JCPS High School Progression, Promotion and Grading Publications, the Kentucky Program of Studies, SBDM Policies and JCPS Policies.

When developing student schedules, consideration must be given to transcript review, needs of students, available subjects, class size, race, gender, and teacher contractual obligation. No student shall be assigned to a class or a program solely on the basis of the student's race, color, national origin, gender, religious beliefs or any other legally protected category.
